## GIVE A CHILD A FUTURE: SPONSOR A CHILD!



*My friends and I don't want to live on the streets. We would like to go to school. Can you help us?*

*You CAN make a difference in the life of a streetchild. For less than €1 a day you can offer a former street child a future!*

*Your sponsorship of less than €1 a day will pay for schoolfees, school uniforms, home clothes, food, shoes, pens, pencils, textbooks, exercise books, stationery and personal hygiene items for a child.*

*Actual sponsorship for a primary school child costs only €0.54 a day, for a vocational training student €0.83 a day and a sponsorship for a secondary school child costs only €0.89 per day.*

**Sponsor a Primary School child** (feeding, clothing, wellbeing & school expenses):

€ 16,25 per month

€ 195 per year

**Sponsor a Secondary School child** (feeding, clothing, wellbeing, school fees & school expenses):

€ 26,70 per month

€ 320 per year

**Sponsor a Vocational Training student** (feeding, clothing, wellbeing, voc.training material & school expenses):

€ 25 per month

€ 300 per year

# SPONSOR A CHILD: HOW DOES IT WORK?

1. At start you decide whether you want to sponsor a child going to Primary school, Secondary school or Vocational training school.
2. Based on your choice, Samaritan Trust will assign you a child. The amount for school uniforms, school materials, school fees, vocational training & basic education material (if applicable) goes directly to the child. The portion meant for feeding, clothing and the child's wellbeing will be used by Samaritan Trust for the intended purpose, except that it might be used to assist other children at Samaritan too.
3. Independent of the type of education your sponsored child is pursuing, you will receive a report once a year. This report will be preferably sent to you by email as this is faster and cost efficient. If you do not have an email address, we will still send you the report by post.
4. The annual update on the child's wellbeing and school performance will be compiled and written by one of the Samaritan's social workers, who will visit the child's home at least once a year.
5. Personal contact between donor and child is extremely difficult, especially if the donor is outside Malawi. If a donor visiting Malawi wishes to visit the child, this is possible and it is encouraged. It is easy for the donor to meet a child staying at one of Samaritan's centers. Once a child has been reintegrated back home it becomes more difficult because the children's home is usually in the remote areas, which are difficult to access. However, we will do our best to arrange such a meeting if requested.

Samaritan Trust supports street children at 3 levels:

- Primary school
- Vocational skills training
- Secondary school

After primary school, depending on the child's abilities, there are two options:

1. If the child can make it through secondary school, with your continued support, we can send the child to secondary school
2. If the child is not willing or not able to make it through secondary school, then we will recommend vocational training to empower the child. With your continued support the child can get a vocational skills training at Samaritan's skills center or elsewhere near his/her home village.

Your donation can be paid annually or monthly.
